



Carmenère

It's a highly vigorous vine cultivar, with a medium-to-late bud burst and a medium-to-late ripening period.

The grape production is medium and sometimes unsteady. It gives a bodied and fruity ruby-red wine, with an agreeable herbaceous taste. It tolerates short-term ageing (2-3 years).

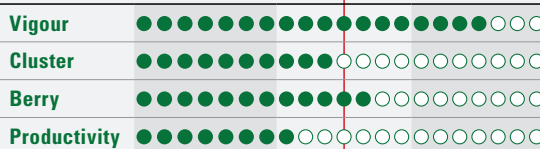

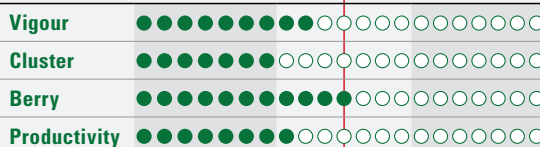
Oenological aptitude: it is suitable for wines with marked herbaceous notes; to be drunk young or after a short ageing period.

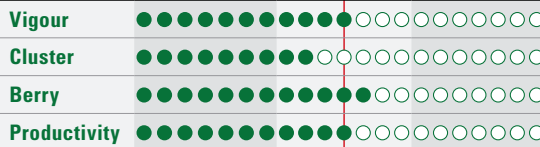
Oenological aptitude: it is suitable for soft and fruity wines with slight herbaceous notes; thank to its excellent structure it fits medium-to-long ageing.

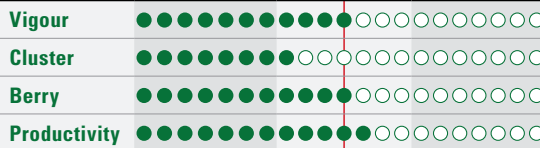
Oenological aptitude: compared with VCR22, this clone is suitable for fresher wines. Thanks to its good structure this clone can be used in Bordeaux blends.

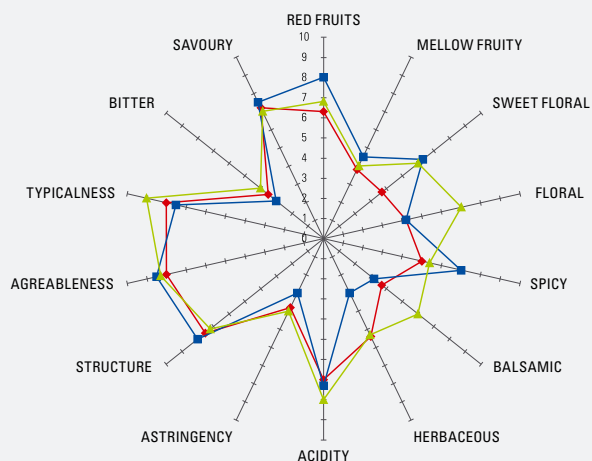

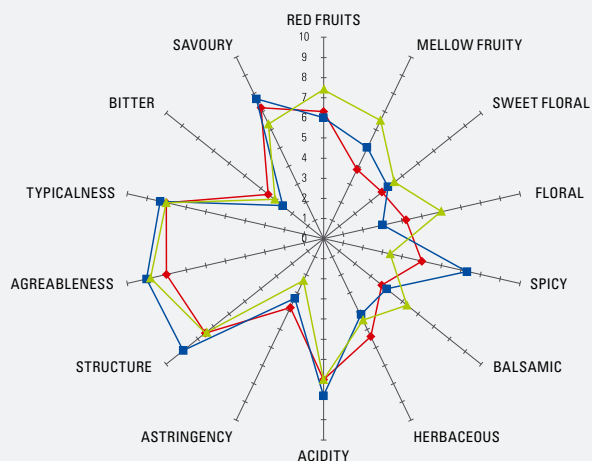
Oenological aptitude: it is suitable for structured wines and also for long-term aging.
