



# Pinot Noir

It is a vine cultivar of medium vigour, with a medium bud burst period and an early maturation period.

The grape production is not abundant.

It gives a delicate wine with a faded ruby-red colour and a fragrant bouquet, which significantly improves with ageing.

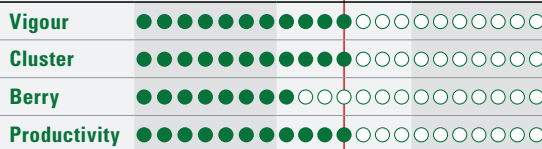
## VCR CLONES

Grave del Friuli



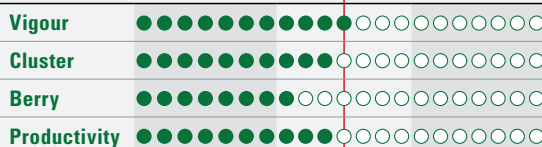
**Oenological aptitude:** this clone is suitable for typical, fully coloured, richly structured wines and also for production of sparkling wines.

California



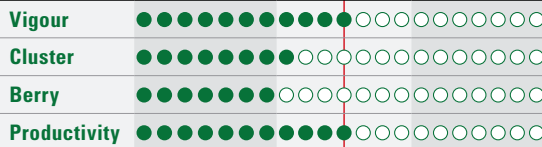
**Oenological aptitude:** this clone gives wines with particular scents of underwood fruits and cherry, suitable both for the vinification of red wines and as a basis for sparkling wines.

Tauriano (PN)



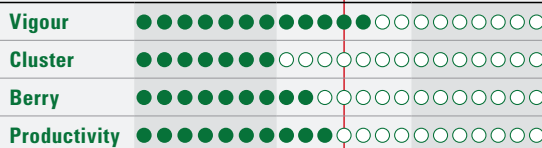
**Oenological aptitude:** this clone is suitable for perfumed and intensely coloured wines and for medium-to-long ageing period.

Average of the cultivar



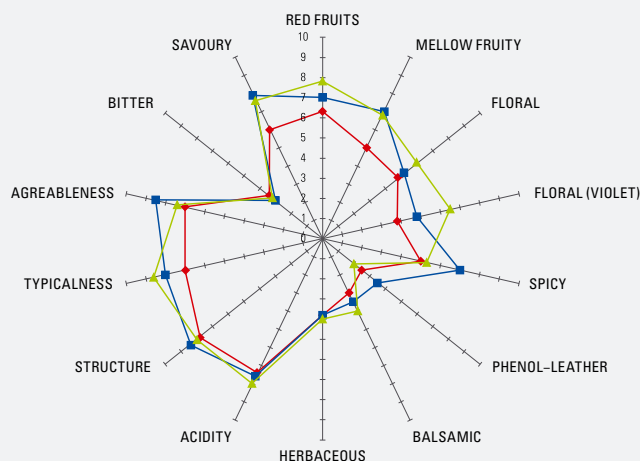

Torrazza Coste (PV)



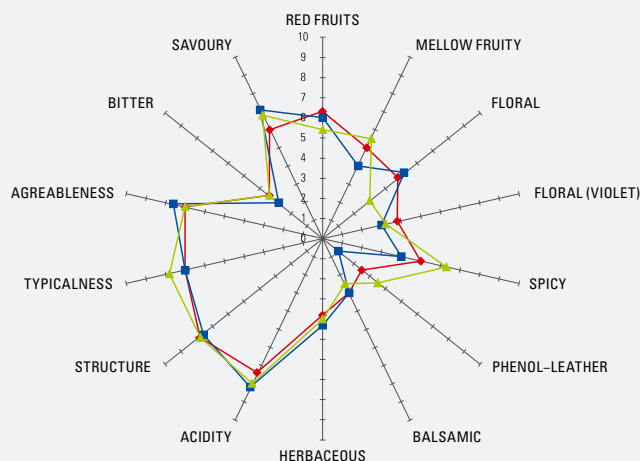
**Oenological aptitude:** this clone is suitable for particularly aromatic wines, rich in anthocyanins and polyphenols; it is also suitable for ageing.
