



# Verdicchio Bianco (White Verdicchio)

It is a very vigorous vine cultivar, with a medium-to-late bud burst and a late maturation period. The grape production is good and rather constant. It gives a lively, dry in taste, delicately perfumed and agreeably bitterish, straw-yellow wine with greenish reflections and a slender body.

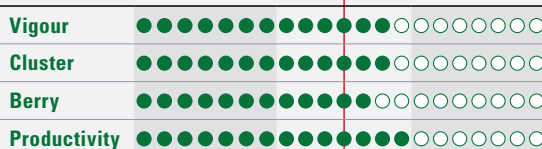
## VCR CLONES

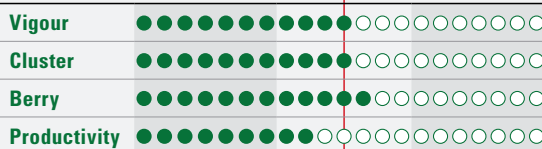
**Oenological aptitude:** this clone is suitable for wines with excellent structure, acidity and sharp flowery-fruity perfumes.

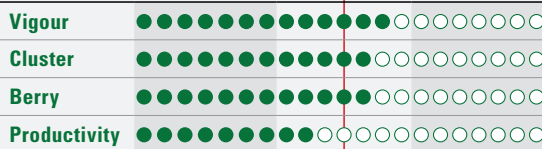
**Oenological aptitude:** this clone is suitable for aged wines with fruity perfumes and very good structure.

### VCR28 (BIOTYPE: VALTENESI)

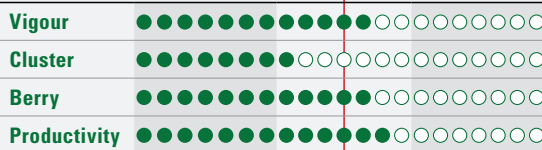
**Oenological aptitude:** this clone is suitable for wines with flowery-fruity perfumes, excellent structure and acidity. Blending with VCR3 is indicated both for aged wines and both for dessert wines.

Average of the cultivar



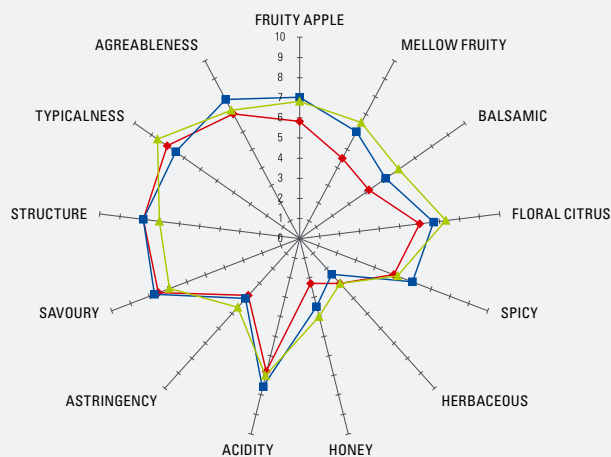

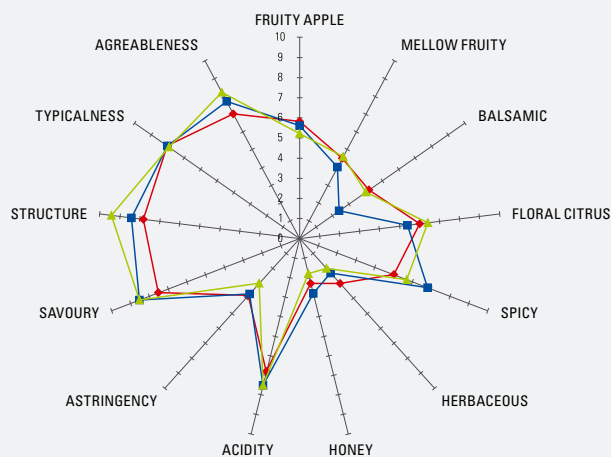
**Oenological aptitude:** this clone is suitable for fresh and young wines with flowery notes, medium structure and acidity.
